Fire Safety

There are **four** essential steps to take if you discover a fire:

R	A	C	E
Rescue anyone in immediate danger of the fire.	Alarm Activate the nearest fire alarm and call your fire response telephone number.	Contain fire by closing all doors in the fire area.	Extinguish small fires. If the fire cannot be extinguished, leave the area and close the door.

You should know:

- Locations of nearest fire extinguishers and alarm pull boxes
- The fire location - room number and building
- All fire exits in your work area

Fire safety on a construction site is vital. Most construction sites are built before sprinklers and alarms are installed. It is your job to watch out for fires while you are working. Around a construction site it is common to have many different chemicals that could ignite and fuel a fire.

Workers should be diligent when working around certain chemicals as it could start a fire.

How to properly operate a Fire Extinguisher

P	A	S	S
Pull the pin, release a lock latch or press a puncture lever.	Aim the extinguisher at the base of the fire.	Squeeze the handle of the fire extinguisher.	Sweep from side-to-side at the base of the flame.
